

How to Measure your Dog

The easiest way is to find a suitable corner in your home and put your dog's bottom into the corner and their side should rest flat against the wall.



A LENGTH

cm

From the tip of the nose to the base of the tail (excluding the tail itself).

D LENGTH of FRONT LEG

cm

From the ground to his or her elbow (left or right will do!).

B HEIGHT STANDING

cm

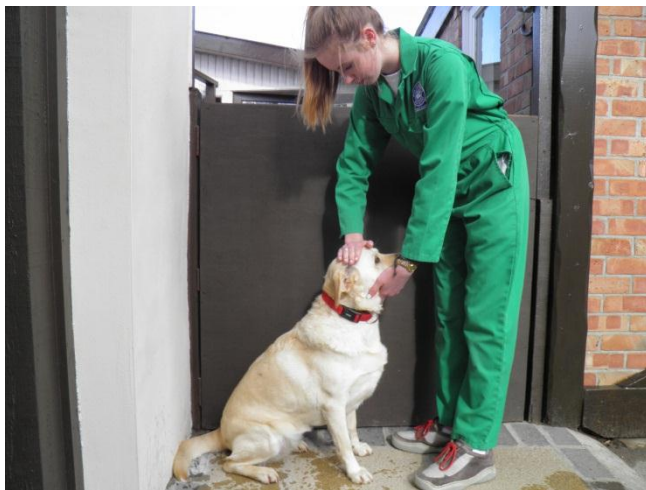
From the ground to his or her highest point (normally the top of the head, or in some cases his or her ears!).



C WIDTH

cm

Measure the widest point of his or her body whatever that happens to be!



E HEIGHT SITTING UPRIGHT

cm

Again, from the ground to the highest point.

We will use these measurements to assess the travel box size to ensure your dog will have sufficient space to stand up and lie down so they will be comfortable but not larger than necessary so costs are kept to a minimum (and so you dog doesn't have too much space which can also be unsafe).
